You are invited to watch the children sing Thanksgiving songs!

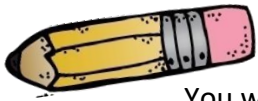

Cook over medium heat until thick, use a nonstick pan.
Knead by hand or machine till smooth.
